The headline and items build into place.

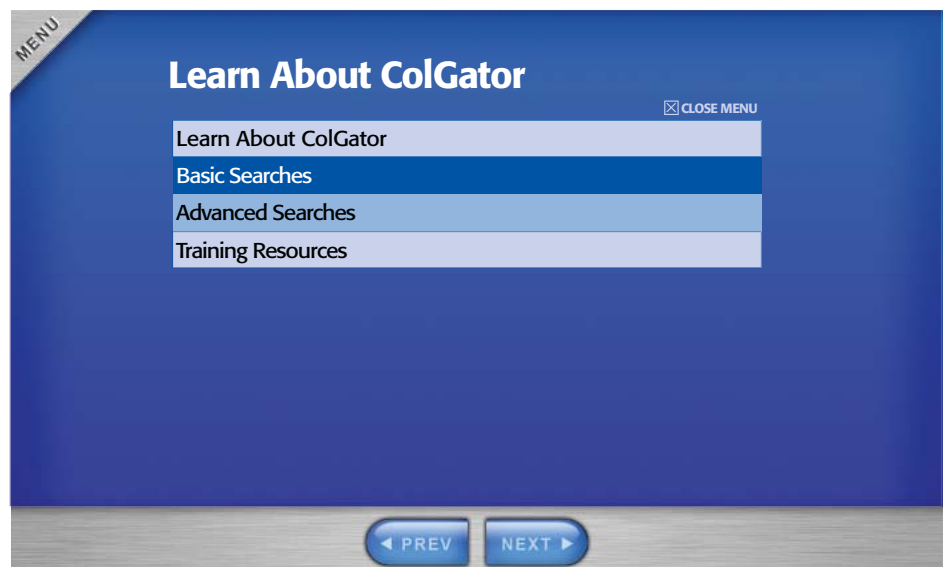
The copy at the bottom informs users on what the *Prev/Next* and *Menu* buttons do (the same sequence as the previous Flash pieces)

In the menu to the right, the current section the user is in is *Basic Searches*. If a user rolls over a topic, the background turns a slightly darker blue (as seen in *Advanced Searches*).

A title and left side content area that will build along with a view screen that will demo the topic feature.

Under each animation, 4 control buttons allow users to *Rewind, Pause, Play, or Fast Forward.*

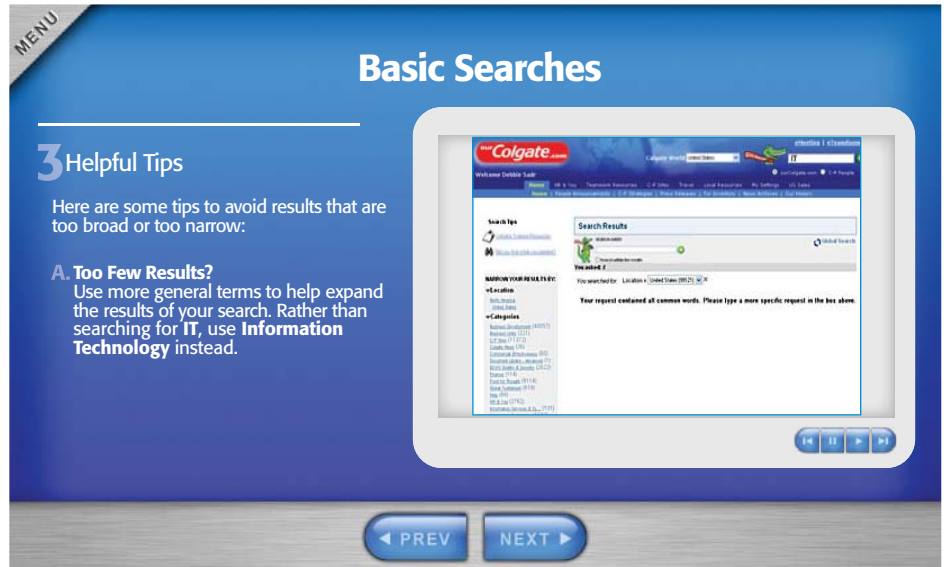
- Use a comma (,) between words to generate results including all or any term entered, e.g. **competitive, newsletter, april** will return items with both computer and purchase results

A visual representation of “too few results” is shown. A new TV screen is shown displaying a more useful search result.

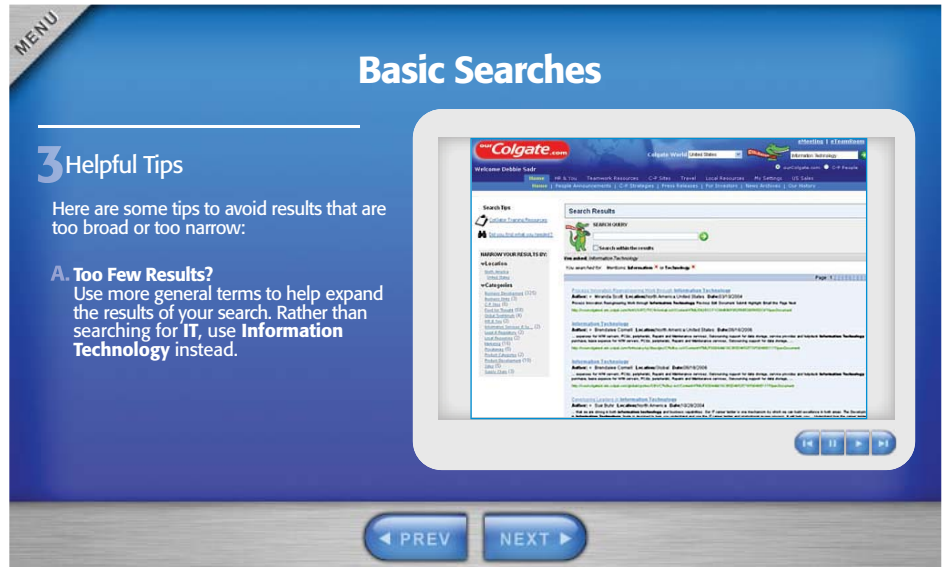
At the end of each section, a “Section Completed” icon appears at the end of the copy block. The piece will pause at this point until the user clicks *Next*.

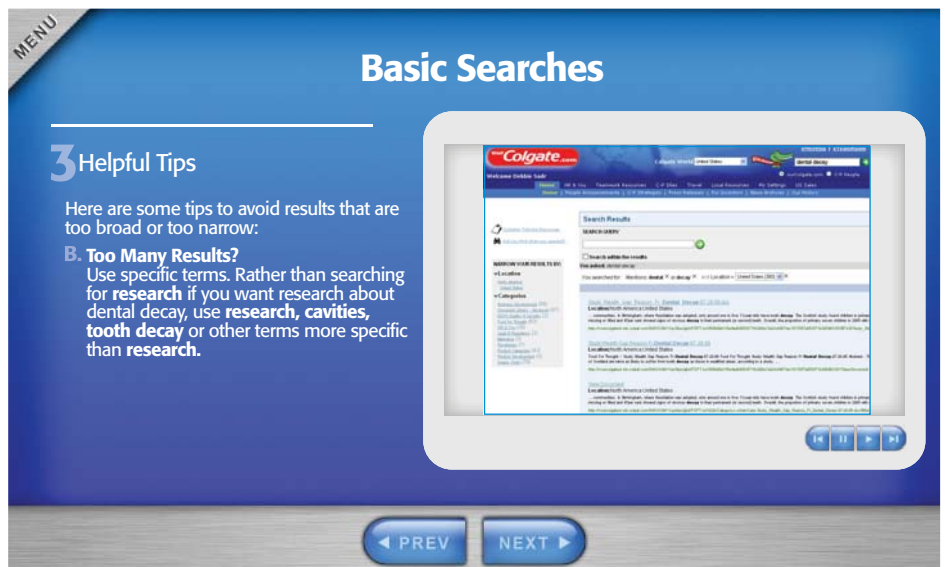
Zoom into the search field and type in Information Technology. The mouse then clicks the submit button. The results are then shown.

The piece will pause at this point until the user clicks *Next*.

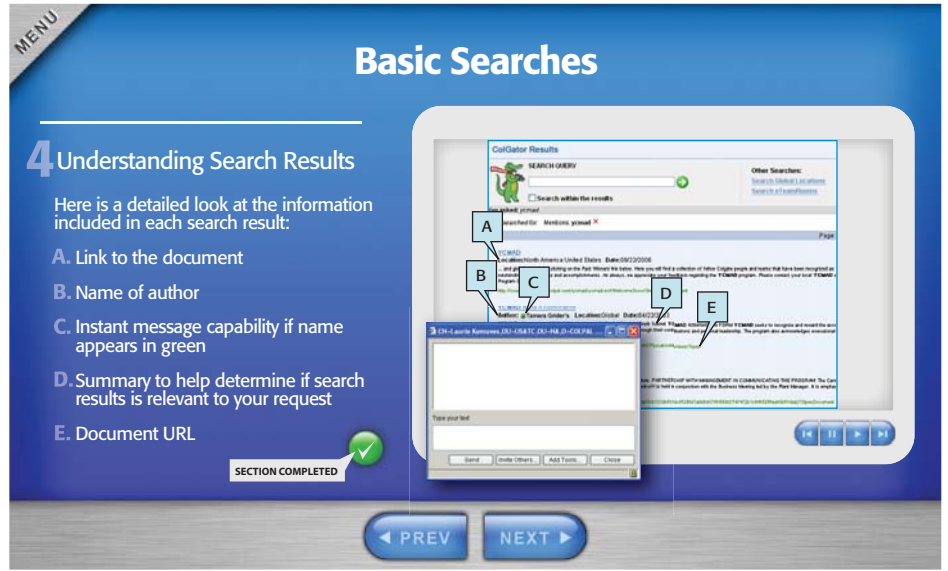

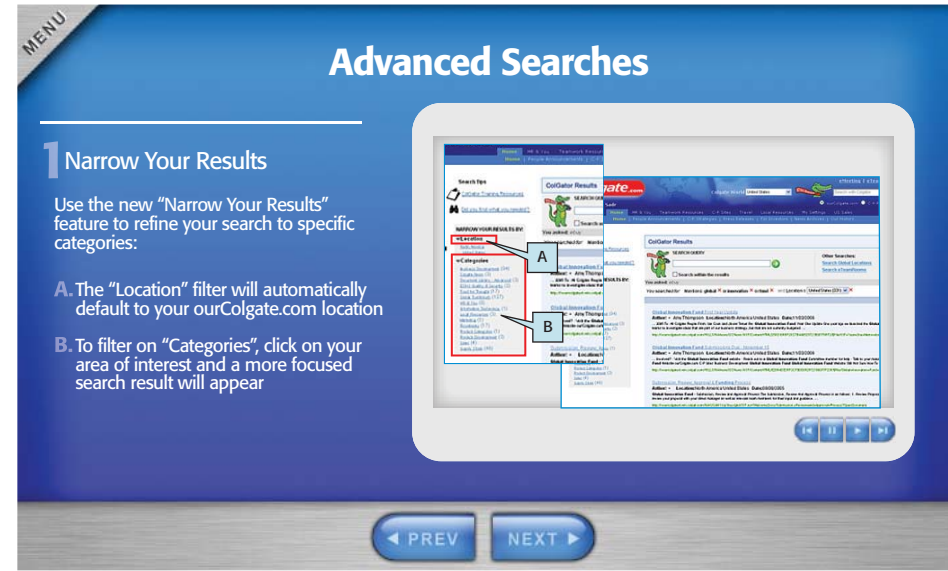

Advanced Searches

3 Search Global Locations

Initially, ColGator searches and displays results relevant to your ourColgate.com default location (i.e., North America for users in the United States). You can search other ourColgate.com locations by doing a global search:

- Click the "Search Global Locations" link at the top of the search results page
- Re-enter your search term in the "Search Query" field
- The "Location" filter expands to include all regions and countries with results relevant to your search
- Click on the location specific to your interest

Advanced Searches

4 Search eTeamRooms

ColGator's advanced features allow you to search eTeamRooms to find the latest documents about a topic of interest. A key symbol is displayed to highlight that the search results are from an eTeamRoom.

- Click the "Search eTeamRooms" link at the top of the search results page
- Re-enter in your search term in the "Search Query" field
- If you are a member of the eTeamRoom, click on the document link to access
- If you are not a member, request access to the document by clicking on the key symbol
- A pre-formatted form will open to help you contact the eTeamRoom managers

Note: eTeamRoom managers have final authority to grant access
